**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN:** Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, on April 24, 2019, the Niles Charter Township Board approved a resolution formally requesting a speed study on Adams Road from Ontario Road to State Line Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the traffic on Adams Road from Ontario Road to State Line Road has steadily increased over the past years due to development and growth in the township; and

**WHEREAS**, it has become increasingly difficult for residents to negotiate left hand turns, or move into and out of the flow of traffic safely due to the increased traffic volume; and

**WHEREAS**, the Niles Charter Township Board understands that the Berrien County Road Department in cooperation with the Michigan State Police will use engineering data gathered in a speed study to make a decision which could raise the speed limit, lower the speed limit, or keep the speed limit the same; and

**WHEREAS**, the Niles Charter Township Board will abide by the decision made by the Berrien County Road Department and the Michigan State Police as a result of the speed study.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Berrien County Road Department, in coordination with the Michigan State Police, to conduct a speed study on Adams Road from Ontario Road to State Line Road in Niles Charter Township for the purposes of determining a reasonable and safe speed limit.
