

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Personnel and Human Services Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Berrien County G.I.S. Mapping Department desires to contract with Michigan's Department of Technology, Management & Budget [Michigan Statewide Authoritative Imagery and LiDAR Program (MiSAIL)] to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for data exchange; and

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan will provide 6" pixel resolution, 4 band (red, green, blue, near-infrared) aeriels to Berrien County at a buy-in price of \$28,244.16 which is \$42.03 per square mile for 672 square miles flown; and

WHEREAS, to enter into this MiSAIL agreement Berrien County would provide:

- **Tax Parcels (GIS):** Geometry and attributes for Community Parcel Repository to be used by all of the State of Michigan's Agencies. This data would be updated 1-2 times per year
- **Address Points:** Geometry and attributes for structure point location at rooftop driveway, geocoded along road centerline, or parcel centroid, and updated 4 times per year, and would be used by all of the State of Michigan Agencies.
- **Road Centerlines:** Geometry and attributes; and updated 4 times per year, and made publicly available

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan is authorized to pass through to the United States Census Bureau both the Address Points and the Road Centerlines; and

WHEREAS, Corporate Counsel has reviewed the service agreement with Michigan's Statewide Authoritative Imagery and LiDAR Program (MiSAIL) and has approved to form.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairperson or his designee to execute the Service Agreement with the Department of Technology, Management & Budget, and directs the GIS/Land Description Administrator to proceed with the purchase order.


