RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Health Department (BCHD) operates the Triple P – Positive Parenting Program and will be implementing the Taking Pride in Prevention Program beginning in October 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Department has been awarded additional grant funding to support these programs and expand services for Berrien County residents and requires additional personnel support to meet community and programmatic needs; and

WHEREAS, after review of the staffing needs for appropriately supporting these programs, it has been determined that optimal program operations necessitate the addition of a Health Educator which will provide coordination and support for both Triple P and Taking Pride in Prevention Program service delivery; and

WHEREAS, current funding from the Children’s Trust Fund, United Way of Southwest Michigan and Michigan Department of Health and Human Services will support this position full time; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners create this classification effective on the date of this resolution:
