



Kirtland's Warbler Trip

31 May-1 June, 2022

Hello Birders!

The BBC is going on the road, guiding a trip north to see the **Kirtland's Warbler**.

This trip will be limited to 14 people and cost will be \$135 per person. This includes motel, Tuesday lunch and private guided tour at Hartwick Pines State Park. If you split a room with someone, the cost will be \$70 per person. Also, if you drive you will receive \$30 per person that carools with you.

During our trip we will make 5 to 6 stops along the AuSable Birding Trail between Tuesday and Wednesday. Aside from the Kirtland's Warbler we might have a chance to see Common Loons, Black Terns, Clay-colored Sparrows and Evening Grosbeaks, to name a few.

A convoy will leave Love Creek early Tuesday morning, May 31st and return Wednesday night. A full itinerary will be provided at least 2weeks before the trip. A \$50 deposit is required to hold your reservation and needs to be in no later than May 22nd.

We hope this opportunity spikes your interest and you get chance to see the rare Kirtland's Warbler!!
