RE: Berrien County Damage Assessment Executive Summary From Feb. Flooding/Heavy Rains

Dear Senator and Representatives,

It is our understanding that on March 8<sup>th</sup>, the Michigan State Police presented preliminary damage estimates to representatives from Gov. Snyder's Office. It is our intent to also share these initial numbers with you for your general knowledge. The reports are preliminary estimates and the numbers will be adjusted as additional information is learned. For that reason, we ask that these numbers and reports not be shared generally with anyone who does not have a need to know. Our intent is to ensure confusion will not exist if numbers do change in light of damage we may not have yet found, or if insurance adjustments are applied. Our initial report had a deadline of 3 days to collect the information which fed the data for these reports. Additional and more detailed reports regarding the incident will be compiled over the several months to follow, after we ensure the impacted public is safe and well.

This report will begin with Berrien County detailed damage estimates, progress into statewide private property comparisons, statewide public property comparisons, a statewide summary comparison, and will end with a comparison of the counties within the MSP 5<sup>th</sup> District of southwest lower Michigan.

If you have any questions regarding the incident, please reach out to the Sheriff, our Commissioners, or our County Administrator and we will be sure to provide assistance in finding the answers.
