TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Finance Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in 1971 and 1972 the County of Berrien acquired property in Coloma Township, commonly known as tax identification number 11-08-0020-0016-03-5, to construct the Paw Paw Lake Waste Water Treatment Plant; and,

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Board of Public Works issued bonds pursuant to Public Act 185 of 1957 to defray the cost of constructing this plant; and,

WHEREAS, the terms of these bonds directed the County of Berrien to convey title to the property to the Paw Paw Lake Waste Water Treatment Plant once these bonds had been retired; and

WHEREAS, these bonds were fully retired in 1992.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners hereby conveys and warrants all rights, title and interest in parcel 11-08-0020-0016-03-5 to the Paw Paw Lake Waste Water Treatment Plant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Berrien County Administrator is authorized to sign all documents necessary to complete this conveyance subject to the review and approval of those documents by the Berrien County Corporate Counsel.
