TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2021, the Three Oaks Township Board approved a resolution formally requesting a speed limit study on Three Oaks Road from the south Three Oaks Village limit to the Indiana State Line, which is currently 55 MPH; and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2021, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorized a speed limit study on Three Oaks Road from the south Three Oaks Village limit to the Indiana State Line via Resolution #A2105231; and

WHEREAS, a traffic engineering study has been conducted by the Berrien County Road Department and the Michigan State Police on Three Oaks Road from the south Three Oaks Village limit to the Indiana State Line; and

WHEREAS, Traffic Control Order S 11-13-21 has been issued by the Michigan State Police stating that it has been determined from this study that a reasonable and safe speed limit on Three Oaks Road in Three Oaks Township is 55 miles per hour (MPH) and rescinds the previous traffic control order, S 11-329-71.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners hereby sets the speed limit on Three Oaks Road in Three Oaks Township to 55 MPH and authorizes the Road Department Director to sign Traffic Control Order No. S 11-13-21 establishing the speed limit, as aforementioned in this resolution, and directs the Road Department to remove any other speed limit signs.
