

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Personnel and Human Services Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Berrien County's Health Department (BCHD) applied for funding from the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) (application approved under Resolution P2112385) for the education, communication, and outreach regarding the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act; and

WHEREAS, the BCHD wishes to accept the grant funds of \$42,577, for the grant period January 1, 2022 to September 15, 2022, to be used for the continuation of an educational prevention campaign started in FY2021 regarding medical marijuana, aimed at key target audiences including youth and pregnant women; and

WHEREAS, the grant money is distributed proportionately based on the number of registry identification cards issued to or renewed for the residents of each county and Berrien County currently has 2,089 patient registry cards issued and/or renewed; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Health endorses this resolution, pending approval of Corporate Counsel.


