

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is planning to participate in the Federal program identified as the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CM); and

WHEREAS, MDOT has approved the following project utilizing CM funds: Hot mix asphalt non-motorized pathway along Snow Road from Berrien Springs south village limits southwesterly to approximately 2,750 feet southwesterly of Shawnee Road, including earth work, storm sewer, concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk ramps, retaining wall and permanent pavement markings, all together with necessary related work; and

WHEREAS, MDOT is planning to participate in the Federal program identified as the Highway Infrastructure Program (HI); and

WHEREAS, MDOT has approved the following project utilizing HI funds: Hot mix asphalt non-motorized pathway along Snow Road from Shawnee Road southwesterly to Berrien Springs south village limits, including earthwork, storm sewer, concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk ramps, retaining wall and permanent pavement markings, all together with necessary related work; and

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost of the project as described in Contract #22-5335 is \$345,600 with federal funds covering \$205,704 of the cost; and


WHEREAS, the balance of the project, \$139,896, is being funded through the Berrien County Road Department (as the fiduciary) by Oronoko Charter Township; and

WHEREAS, this is an MDOT project and thus they will be doing the bidding for the project; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for Berrien County to execute Contract #22-5335 with MDOT for the project to proceed.


